SUBJECT: FIRST CONNECTION OF ELECTRONIC UNIT IN SEQUENTIAL SYSTEM

We kindly advise you that **the first start of the ECU in sequential systems**, if the ECU is coming brand new from our warehouse in Italy, could lead to a configuration problem with PC.

This may happen by using the sequential software new version 5.0.0 and 5.0.0.1 which are available since last May 2nd 2007.

The problem consists of **engine running on petrol instead of LPG/CNG below 4400rpm**, while switch indicates functioning on LPG/CNG. Only after 4400rpm the system works correctly.

It will soon be available a new updated version of the Software that will solve this problem.

Meanwhile you may solve this problem the following way:

A) New ECU: it is possibile to start correctly the new ECU by connecting the absolute first time with a previous version of the software.

For this purpose we have uploaded again online the previous version 4.9.8 C that may be downloaded by connecting to the private area of our website <u>www.tartariniauto.it</u> under menu Car Data Sheet / Technical Area / Software Programs / Sequential Fuel Injection System / Sequential Software Version 4.9.8 C.zip.

B) ECU already started and that are showing the problem: it is possibile to **re-start it using version 4.9.8 C or a previous version of this software, by clicking on "Restart ECU from Base Parameters" in menu "CONFIGURATION".**

C) In case ECU have already been started and they don't show this malfunction, there is no problem.

We remain at your complete disposal for further information or clarifications.
